Course Selection Reminders:

- 12th graders are required to enroll in six classes.
- Math and English placement depends on prior course work, previous grades, and placement scores- teachers determine class placement.
- English, World Language, Social Science, Science, and Math are required courses.
- It is not recommended to take more than three HL courses in one year.
- It is recommended to start in level one of all World Language courses unless you are a native speaker/writer in that particular language.
- In order to move to a higher level of World Language, students must test with the language teacher.
